Every year, thousands of inmates die while incarcerated. Around 40% of these deaths are the result of cardiovascular or respiratory illness, overdose, detox or suicide. These deaths are also a costly expense, with the average inmate death in Canada estimated to cost \$1 million taxpayer dollars. The challenges are urgent and pervasive — but they're not inevitable. Xandar Kardian's autonomous, radar-based vital signs monitoring can help protect inmates' safety while prioritizing privacy, security and staff's wellbeing. The company's cutting-edge UWB radar technology, including its flagship XK300 sensor, react to the micro-vibrations of the human body, such as a heart beating or lung

pumping, for highly accurate vital sign measurements. Importantly, the Xandar Kardian sensors require no wearables on the inmate, no video or audio recordings, no software to operate, and no battery to change – providing a completely autonomous, continuous and privacy-secure health-monitoring solution.

“The corrections industry remains rife with controversy, but everyone agrees that an inmate should be safe and receive care if needed,” said Sam Yang, Cofounder and Managing Director of Xandar Kardian. “Partnering with companies like GT Global Services expands our footprint and empowers us to address a core issue in the jail and prison system, which is inmate health. Our radar-based technology provides critical health data while being HIPAA-compliant, and we know that more people having access to it means more lives saved.”

Once deployed, Xandar Kardian’s sensors are linked to a secure local network that provides a “paper trail” of data for each inmate, minimizing organizational risk and serving as an extremely useful resource should additional medical intervention be required from hospital providers.
